Donations recognized were:

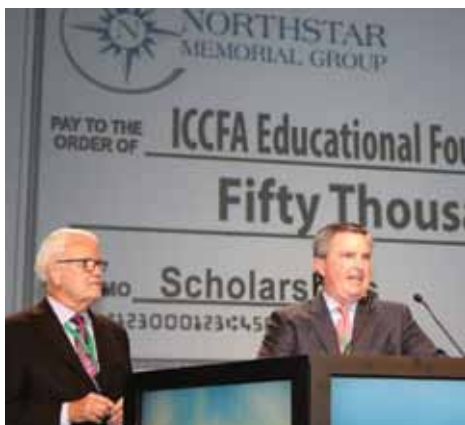
- Homesteaders Life, \$75,000,
